Job description

PURPOSE: The Communication and Internationalisation Project Manager will design, coordinate and implement the comprehensive strategy for communication, dissemination, internationalisation and exploitation of the RECUP-DAS project results.

JOB TITLE: Work Package 5 Project Manager - Communication and Internationalisation;

LOCATION: ICT-Core premises in Seville, Spain;

POSITION: Full-Time, 24 months;

FUNDING RESOURCES: Project RECUP-DAS (ERDF, Andalusia).

Main responsibilities

- They will coordinate the implementation of Work Package 5, ensuring compliance with milestones and deliverables related to communication, internationalisation, dissemination and exploitation of results;
- They will be supervised by the Communications Officer of the Service Centre for the implementation of LifeWatch ERIC Communication Strategy;
- They will support and supervise the Multichannel Communication and Dissemination Plan for the RECUP-DAS Project;
- They will establish strategic international alliances, integrating the project into sustainability platforms, agendas and networks;

- They will coordinate scientific and technical dissemination, facilitating publications, participation in events and visibility on open science platforms;
- They will support the development and implementation of the strategy for the exploitation and sustainability of results, including FAIR digitalisation, repositories and reusable outputs;
- They will support the transfer of results and knowledge generated, including the future valorisation of mining waste;
- They will prepare reports and content tailored to different audiences: technical, scientific, institutional and citizens;
- They will collaborate with the LifeWatch ERIC Project Operational Coordinator to ensure the cross-cutting integration of WP5 results into the project as a whole;

The ideal candidate should meet the following requirements

- A bachelor's degree in Environmental sciences, or Life Sciences with specialisation in Scientific communication;
- Minimum 5-year experience in R&D projects related to sustainability, communication or environmental management;
- Proven experience on:
 - Scientific communication strategies;
 - Dissemination and exploitation within the framework of European programmes;
 - Open science, FAIR standards, open data platforms (EOSC, GBIF, etc.);
 - Coordination of institutional networks and international relations;
- Proficient in English (minimum C1 level);

- Proven organisation and communication skills, proactivity, capacity of working in teams and under tight deadlines, in international environments and in multi-language contexts;
- Availability to travel abroad occasionally according to the specific working needs of this position;
- High-standards of work ethics.

The vacancy is subject to the following procedure

- The selection process will follow the Employment Policy of LifeWatch ERIC;
- Only shortlisted candidates will be re-contacted. Selected candidates may be called for an interview.
- Interviews will take place from **13 March 2026 to 20 March 2026**;
- They will be appointed for a 24-month period. A competitive gross salary, 40.000,00 - 45.000,00 € based on the qualifications and experience of the candidate, will be offered. Employment will be in Spain, following Spanish employment law and subject to a 180-day trial (probation) period;
