A. Job description

JOB TITLE: Legal and Capacity Building Framework Assistant for Ecosystems Services (LCBFAFES)

LOCATION: LifeWatch ERIC ICT-Core premises in Andalusia (Spain)

POSITION: Full-time

B. Main responsibilities

- S/he will work under the supervision of, and directly report to, the IP of the Andalusia ERDF projects (Chief Technology Officer/Director of the ICT-Core);
- He/she must manage legal and capacity building issues about ecosystems services (eHorse-EponaWatch);

- S/he must design and develop programmes in several matters such as: internships/volunteering, training at all educational stages and gender (GenderWatch);
- In addition, the individual would require experience in coordinating and disseminating the above-mentioned activities.

C. The ideal candidate should meet the following requirements:

1. A Bachelor's degree in Law;
2. Postgraduate experience in Education/Humanities/Social Sciences;
3. Minimum 5 years experience working in the legal sector;
4. Minimum 10 years experience working in the field of Education: Teaching, Training, Internships/Volunteering, Coordination, Management (university level desirable);
5. Accredited experience working with horses;
6. Advanced knowledge in ethology of wild/semi-feral horses;
7. Excellent presentation and reporting skills, fluency in written and spoken Spanish (C2) (ERDF regulations compulsory issue, and ICT-FEDERTECH Offices premises hosted by Spain);
8. Excellent presentation and reporting skills, fluency in written and spoken English (C1 mandatory);
9. Ability to work under tight deadlines with changing priorities;
10. A high-standard work ethic;
11. Availability to work from Matalascañas (eBRIC) once a week.

ADDITIONAL DESIRABLE SKILLS

- A strong knowledge about the idiosyncrasy and sociology of the different regions of Spain;
- Intercultural competence;

- Knowledge and vision about the legacy, present and future of feral/semi-feral horses worldwide;
- Awareness of languages and their influence on biodiversity and gender;
- Experience in activism in matters such as: nature, gender and culture.

- This position is a full-time job. Her/his main office will be located at the LifeWatch ERIC ICT-Core/FEDERTECH premises in Seville (Spain), without prejudice to the establishment of others in the future.
